

Mrs Luna Abbadi is a lawyer who graduated from the University of Jordan, currently married to Makram Queisi, with whom she has three children. In 2003, Mrs Abbadi worked as a legal advisor at Cairo Amman Bank for ten years before moving to the public sector to serve as the Director of the Competition department and as the Deputy Secretary General and Spokesperson for the Ministry of Industry and Trade.



In 2007, she moved to Vienna, Austria, where her husband, Mr Queisi was appointed Jordanian Ambassador for a period of six years followed by a move to Paris, France where he was appointed Ambassador to France. During her time in Vienna, Mrs Abbadi completed her Masters in Business Administration, MBA, in Public Governance and Management at Modul University.
